In this talk, Dr Garton will provide context about Aotearoa New Zealand (NZ), and will present the research she has been involved in that monitors the healthiness of NZ food environments, working alongside researchers (and postgraduate students) who are part of the INFORMAS NZ.

This includes monitoring of the digital food marketing environment (on Facebook, Youtube and company websites), and outdoor food advertising in school zones, and evaluative research to support the healthy school lunch programme.

She will also discuss the global networking activities of INFORMAS, focusing on efforts for capacity building and learning from success between food environments researchers in over 40 countries.
